




Living in the Dark

First, let me tell you a little about myself: My name is Kenton. I am 15, and I live in the Victorville/Hesperia area. All my life I have just wanted affection from someone. Not the affection you get from relatives, but the affection you would receive from a friend. Someone to spend time with me. Someone to be there when I cried. I never truly had a friend, because we moved a lot due to my parents' profession. Although it can be difficult, I am still very proud and thankful my parents served in the U.S. Armed Forces and sacrificed com-



fort, stability, and many other things for our country. However, I never stayed in one place for more than a year, and I always had a hard time meeting people.

After many years, I finally settled down in the High Desert when I was in the 6th grade. I was in a new place, it was at a time in my life when I was changing and felt lonely. This lead me into a downward state of depression. Every day I would wake up without a smile, feeling more worthless than the day before. It really hurt to be depressed and it consumed my life. I started getting bad grades, hanging with the wrong people, making dumb decisions.

Fast forward to the present. I'm now in 9th grade. I had been longing for something so much, I wanted to start putting in time and action to feel better. I knew I wanted a dog, for a dog is supposedly man's best friend. I believed that friendship could be the very affection I had been yearning for. A dog could be there for me to hold and interact with, and the dog would be non-judgmental. So I did a search for dog adoption centers around the area, and I found Beagles & Buddies. It caught my eye because it is the only no-kill shelter in the area. I did some research to see if Beagles & Buddies would be a good place to adopt a dog. It is a non-profit organization, which is better for the community. It has an amazing volunteer program, which I even volunteered for.

I went to Beagles & Buddies and introduced myself. I Connie, and on that same day I met my best friend, 12-week old pup that was previously abused and abanof everyone. He will come lie on me and cuddle. He cheers me up and never makes me unhappy. I started to stop feeling depressed because of him.

Then I had a bad break-up, and that really tore me down. Now, be warned that I am going to touch on a sensitive subject, but in order to put this in perspective it needs to be mentioned...suicide. At that moment in my life, I felt so low that I attempted suicide at my home. Sparing you some gruesome details, I suddenly re-

alized... Wait... I don't want to die! And there was Ragnar. Instinctively, he must've known what I was doing, or maybe he just really needed my attention, because he started barking like crazy.

Ragnar's barking drew attention to what was going on, and someone who means a lot to me saw me and saved my life. I'm glad now that I am alive, but if not for my best friend Ragnar, I might not have had the opportunity to share my story. I hold him every day, not letting go and being thankful for meeting him. Which inadvertently is even a bigger thanks to Beagles & Buddies for turning on the light.

Andrea, the crew's job coach, expressed the teams job motivation and vision has more clarity and confidence which has led them on a more successful path with self-sufficiency.


